The veterans were surprised last night with the news that they were getting the new homes – and surprised again today to find the mortgage-free homes gifted to them were also fully furnished and stocked with many daily necessities.

“These very deserving veterans and their families got a fresh start today. We hope their new Centex home will help provide them with many future happy memories,” said Laurin Darnell, president of PulteGroup's San Antonio Division. “We are forever grateful for the sacrifices they have made and hope these new homes will also help these families make the transition back into civilian life a little easier and a lot less stressful.”

The new 2,458-square-foot homes were built by PulteGroup contractors in the San Antonio area, and fully furnished and accessorized by Pulte's in-house Interiors Design team.

A team of volunteers helped put the finishing touches on both homes earlier this week – from landscaping, to assembling playground equipment, to painting. As a result, his right arm was amputated and he has undergone numerous surgeries.

Randy K. Robinson, 30, served as an Army Sergeant in Afghanistan where he was involved in a vehicle crash that caused his combat vehicle to roll down the side of a mountain, hitting multiple improvised explosive devices. He is married with three sons (ages 3, 5 and 6) and a daughter (age 3), and hopes to start a business that funds retreats for veterans to assist with their healing.

“It is truly an honor to present these two deserving families with a new home they can call their own,” said Winell Herron, H-E-B Group Vice President of Public Affairs and Diversity. “They have sacrificed so much for our country, and we are thrilled to help these families get back on their feet and start this exciting new chapter of their lives.” H-E-B partners from Unilever and Anheuser-Busch were on hand for the home presentation.
